Assessment of Results

Group A: You are interested or skilled with theatrics and pageantry.

Potential Positions: Ceremonialist, Ceremonies Committee, Costume Committee, Dance Team Committee

<u>Group B</u>: You are interested or skilled with communication and can use that to benefit the lodge with inductions, camping promotions, unit elections, or as a secretary.

Potential Positions: Lodge or Chapter Secretary, Camping Promotions Committee, Social Media Committee, Ordeal Chairman, Brotherhood Chairman, Vigil Honor Chairman, Unit Elections Committee

<u>Group C</u>: You are interested or skilled with communication and leadership and can use that to benefit the lodge in a leadership role.

Potential Positions: Lodge or Chapter Chief, Lodge or Chapter Vice Chief, Projects Committee, Unit Elections Committee, Nominations Committee, Troop Representative Committee

<u>Group D</u>: You are interested or skilled in running events and/or managing the finances of a committee or lodge.

Potential Positions: Food Service Committee, Lodge or Chapter Treasurer, Conclave Chairman, NOAC contingent leader, Banquet Committee

Group E: You are interested or skilled in event planning with a focus on the outdoors.

Potential Positions: Projects Committee, Community Service Committee, Trail Crew Committee
