All of a lodge's petitions should be sent at the same time and must be received at least 45 days before the planned induction date. Do not assume approval or make public announcement until the Vigil Honor certificates and ID cards have been received in the council service center. Councils will be billed \$20 for each approved candidate. Notify the OA director if a candidate is not inducted within one year of the certificate date. Nominations will not be accepted or considered for posthumous awards.
